## 18 September 2024 Secondary – Year 10 Art Visit to Salts Mill in Saltaire

#### Dear Parent/Carer

We are delighted to inform you that we have an exciting opportunity for our Year 10 Art students to experience a trip to Salts Mill in Saltaire, Shipley to see the current David Hockney exhibitions: 'A Year In Normandie' and 'The Arrival of Spring' on **Wednesday 2** October 2024.

We will then do some outdoor drawings to study the immediate environment to support their initial GCSE project on Hockney landscapes.

The school believes wholeheartedly in the value of these experiences and subsidises the cost of all visits as much as possible in an attempt to ensure that these opportunities are accessible and affordable to all. However, the school seldom has the financial resources to pay the full costs. Consequently, a voluntary contribution is normally requested from parents/guardians to make up the shortfall. Please note that without all such voluntary contributions, this visit may have to be cancelled, as the school is not in a position to provide further financial support. Please regard this as an important investment in your child's education.

The cost of the trip is £15 per student, which includes transport and insurance. If you would like your child to attend the visit, please make payment via the Arbor parent portal by Monday 23 September 2024.
