### **Prom Expectations**

As we approach the much-anticipated Prom, we want to ensure that all students enjoy this special event in a safe and positive environment. To achieve this, we would like to remind you of our behaviour expectations.

For students to attend Prom, they must meet the school's **behaviour standards**. This includes maintaining **consistent attendance**, adhering to our code of conduct and demonstrating **respect towards staff and peers**. Any student who fails to meet these expectations may be prohibited from attending the Prom. Non-negotiable targets are:

- Complete all detentions that have been set
- Punctuality to lessons
- Positive attendance
- 100% attendance to all exams

Failure to complete any of the above will put your child's attendance to Prom at risk. A full refund will, however, be given to parents should a ticket have been purchased.

We would encourage you to speak with your child about the importance of positive behaviour and the impact it has on their ability to participate in school events.
