Secondary – Year 11 History Trip

Dear parent / carer

I am writing to offer your child an exciting opportunity of taking part in a Medicine revision day in conjunction with Wolfreton School as part of their preparation for the History GCSE exams in the summer of 2025. Students will travel by coach to Leeds to visit the Thackray Medical Museum and attend a performance of the Doctors Show at Leeds City Varieties Music Hall on **Wednesday 29 January 2025**.

Both the Thackray Medical Museum and the stage performance of the Doctors Show have been specifically designed to supplement and enhance the GCSE History Medicine Through Time unit of work which forms part of the students Paper 1 exam.

The Thackray Museum focuses on life in the Industrial period and medicine through time. While the Doctors Show includes a session on exam skills and a dramatic reconstruction of the most important people in the history of medicine.

The cost of the trip is **£48** per student, which includes transport and insurance.

Places on this trip are limited to 30 students and will be allocated on a first come first served basis.
