Dear Parent/Carer

We are pleased to inform you that we are in the process of organising Year 6 Leavers Hoodies for purchase.

The hoodies will be green and are made from a thick fleecy material with hood and drawstring. They will have learner's forename and the first initial of their surname on the back spelling out '25' (to indicate schools leavers in 2025). Please see sample image below. Our school's name will also be on the front, right hand chest pocket area.



Hoodies will be available in the following sizes:

Ages: 9-11 (30-32") or 12-13 (34") @ £20.00

Size: Extra Small (35"), Small (36"), Medium (38"), Large (40") Extra Large (42") 2XL (44") @ £20.00

The hoodie supplier, Rawcliffes, have kindly sent some sample sizes for your child to try on. If you would like your child to try one of these hoodies, please come to the school office. We recommend that a parent also comes with the child as we cannot be responsible for choosing the correct size for your child.

Payment must be made on Arbor Pay by 12:30pm no later than Wednesday 23 April. This can be found under School Shop/Products. Please note that due to printing requirements, unfortunately we are not able to accept any orders after this date.

Delivery is expected around mid-May 2025, but we will advise you when the hoodies are available for collection.

As they are not part of the school uniform, learners will be allowed to wear their hoodies like they would a coat (outerwear) from when they arrive. They will not be allowed to wear them inside the school so please retain your child's jumpers/cardigans in case of cold weather in the Summer months. This will be explained to them by Year 6 staff, but we would appreciate you also discussing this with your child.
